



STUBB ALBUM

WE WILL MAKE AN ALBUM WHERE THE PAGES LIE FLAT, LIFTING AND DISPLAYING THE CONTENT.

A stub album is a bookbinding method traditionally used for albums, especially for photographs, drawings, or other mounted materials that add thickness to the pages.

Instead of sewing or gluing the actual content pages directly into the spine, narrow folded strips of paper or card—called stubs—are bound into the spine. The content pages are then attached to these stubbs.

The advantage of this construction is that it creates extra space at the spine for each page, allowing the book to close flat even when thicker items are mounted on the pages. It also provides flexibility and durability, making it well-suited for albums, scrapbooks, or collections of samples.

In practice, stub albums often have a characteristic stepped appearance at the spine edge, since the stubs create small offsets between the pages.
